

Have you or a loved one been denied insurance coverage for mental health or addiction treatment services?

Access to mental health, eating disorder, and addiction care is your right. The Federal Parity Law requires insurers to cover illnesses of the brain, such as depression or addiction, no more restrictively than how they cover illnesses of the body, such as diabetes and cancer.

If your health plan denied coverage for mental health or addiction treatment services, there are ways to fight back. Visit The Kennedy Forum's Parity Registry website to:

- Send a complaint directly to state enforcement officials.
